PRESS RELEASE

Dear friends from the media in Macedonia,

The activities of the OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024, which have been taking place with great success throughout 2024, will have their conclusion on 6 Feb. 2025 (Thu.) at 7 p.m. at the National Gallery of the Republic of Macedonia – Cifte Hammam Skopje with the opening of the official exhibition and presenting of awards and recognitions to artists and collaborators of OSTEN. This event is even more significant given the fact that it is the first in a series of events planned in this jubilee year – 80 years of OSTEN's existence!

Symbolically, the exhibition will feature **80** award-winning artists and finalists from over **40** countries, most of whom are coming to Skopje in person from different parts of the world to receive the awards. Works of visual arts will be exhibited - art on paper, painting, objects, installations, photographs, video and multimedia art.

OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024 – CHRONOLOGY OF ACTIVITIES

OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024 began with the announcement of the international OPEN CALL, to which **273** artists from **51** countries applied with **863** works!

January - June 2024 the PREVIEW PROGRAM of OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024 took place at the OSTEN Gallery with a series of solo and group exhibitions of the artists who applied;

23.4. - 5.5.2024 the exhibition "The Wheel of Time" by the extraordinary Italian artist Marco Bagnoli (http://www.marcobagnoli.it), which was organized by OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje at NGM - Chifte Hammam in collaboration with ZERYNTHIA (ZERYNTHIA http://www.zerynthia.it) - Association for Contemporary Art from Rome, and with the support of the Italian Institute of Culture and the Italian Embassy Skopje, as an appropriate announcement of the decision of the OSTEN Council "COUNTRY IN FOCUS" at OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024 to be ITALY (more about the event: https://bit.ly/3woHZVw)

11.5.2024 at **12** noon, OSTEN Skopje presented the official award GRAND PRIX for lifetime achievement of OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024 to one of the greatest artists of today - MICHELANGELO PISTOLETTO. In accordance with the desire of the Pistoletto to be a motive for connecting and uniting people and institutions in the region, the award ceremony took place at the Museum of Contemporary Art in Belgrade, as part of the program for his solo exhibition "Preventive Peace". The official GRAND PRIX - a sculpture by Petar Hadzi Boškov, was presented to Maestro Pistoletto by Kornelija Koneska, Executive Director of OSTEN Skopje.

The event was organized in cooperation with the Museum of Contemporary Art in Belgrade, Serbia "Zerynthia" - Association for Contemporary Art, Rome, Italy and Mario Peroni.



27.6.2025 at 19 h. in the OSTEN gallery the OFFICIAL PROGRAM of the OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje 2024 began with the solo exhibition of the self-taught surrealist and great Macedonian painter Vangel NAUMOVSKI – paintings, drawings and graphics (from the OSTEN collection) ... which ran until December 2024 with the group exhibitions of the selected artists of the Biennial;

30.6.2024 was the deadline for the open call, after which the **SELECTION** of artists followed (selector **Kornelija KONESKA, N. Macedonia** https://www.osten.mk/kornelija-koneska)

27-31.8.2024 JURYING was held by an international jury consisting of:

AWARDS from the COUNCIL of AMBASSADORS of OSTEN

The GRAND PRIX for Lifetime Achievement was awarded to Michelangelo PISTOLETTO (b. 1933) — Italian artist (painter, artistic actions, objects) and theorist, one of the founders and main protagonist of Arte Povera, a radical Italian art movement of the last century, whose artists explored a series of unconventional processes and the use of non-traditional "everyday" materials.

The WORLD CULTURAL HERITAGE award was awarded to Vangel NAUMOVSKI – one of the greatest Macedonian artists whom theorists classify as self-taught surrealist painters – quite appropriate to pay tribute to his work on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of his birth (1924 - 2006) and the 100th anniversary of surrealism (1924 - 2024).

SPECIAL GRAND PRIX was awarded to **Simon SEMOV**, N. Macedonia – one of the most prominent artists on the Macedonian contemporary art scene, most specific in his work with handmade paper.

SPECIAL GRAND PRIX to **Mrđan BAJIĆ**, Serbia – one of the most important contemporary artists in Serbia, representative of Serbia at the Venice Biennial, winner of a grant from the Pollock-Krasner Foundation and Knight of the Order of Arts and Letters

The very existence of such an event as the OSTEN BIENNIAL, which is based on the 80-year tradition of OSTEN Skopje (founded in 1945), is a success in itself, because the standards are high and maintaining the level of the event is a challenge.

AWARD SYSTEM AT OSTEN BIENNIAL Skopje

AWARDS from the OSTEN AMBASSADORS COUNCIL

The OSTEN Ambassadors Council is an advisory body composed of artists (as a rule, the winners of the GRAND PRIX for Lifetime Achievement also become OSTEN Ambassadors), art professionals (some of the members of the international jury of the OSTEN Biennial of Drawing), as well as other OSTEN supporters and art lovers. The OSTEN Ambassadors Council proposes and makes a decision on the GRAND PRIX and WORLD CULTURAL HERITAGE awards of each edition of the OSTEN Biennial.

The GRAND PRIX for Lifetime Achievement is awarded to an author who has distinguished himself at the peak of his professional life and whose work represents the highest achievement in world contemporary art (so far awarded: Joseph Kosuth, Ilya and Emilia Kabakov, Pierre Soulages, Tony Cragg, Marina Abramović, Christo, Vladimir Veličković...), and



The WORLD CULTURAL HERITAGE Award refers to the work of a deceased author who has had a strong influence on the world history of art (so far awarded: Pablo Picasso, Victor Vasarely, Salvador Dali, Joan Miró, Henry Moore, Oscar Kokoschka, Rembrandt...)

In cooperation with WAVA – WORLD ASSOCIATION OF VISUAL ARTS*, awards are traditionally awarded as recognition, motivation and encouragement for international artists: REMBRANDT Award for Excellence in Art, ARTIST OF THE WORLD Award, ARTIST OF EUROPE Award and BALKAN ARTIST Award.
